He helps companies as they respond to the simultaneous pressures of globalization, regionalization and localization.

On these topics, he has authored six books and over 3 dozen articles and case studies. Much of his research and writing have focused on Asia, where he has conducted extensive field research from India, to Southeast Asia and China, to Japan.
